Morgan 3 Wheeler 110th Anniversary Edition (2019) – One Owner – LHD

A Morgan 3 Wheeler is difficult to place in any conventional category. It is neither a motorcycle, nor a traditional sports car, nor a classic car – yet it combines elements of all three to create a driving experience entirely of its own. Sitting low to the ground, completely exposed to the elements and with the imposing twin-cylinder engine mounted up front, every journey feels more intense than it would in almost any modern sports car.

This example was supplied new by us in 2019 and now comes directly from its first owner, meaning its complete history is known to us. It is a left-hand-drive 110th Anniversary Edition, produced to celebrate Morgan's 110th anniversary.

Its specification is particularly stylish. The beautiful matt silver metallic bodywork is combined with a warm brown leather interior featuring elegant quilted stitching. The colour scheme is reminiscent of the highly desirable limited-edition Superdry and perfectly complements the adventurous, aviation-inspired character of the 3 Wheeler. A black tonneau cover is also included, protecting the interior and neatly completing its appearance.

At the front sits the air-cooled 2.0-litre S&S V-twin engine, coupled to a five-speed manual gearbox. With a dry weight of just 525 kilograms, the 3 Wheeler does not require extreme speeds to feel spectacular. Every mechanical pulse, corner and change in the road surface becomes part of the experience. Even a drive along a quiet country road soon feels like a small adventure – and that is precisely where its charm lies.

This generation of the Morgan 3 Wheeler was produced from 2011 until 2021 and became one of the most distinctive models in Morgan's modern history.

Thanks to its European type approval, this Morgan can be registered easily in various European countries. It is generally registered as a motorcycle or three-wheeled motor vehicle, resulting in relatively low registration and running costs. Depending on the country and its intended use, it may also offer attractive tax advantages.

This is not a vehicle bought merely to be admired in a collection. It is a reason to take the long way round on a sunny morning, seek out quiet country roads and enjoy an experience that no conventional car can truly replicate. At the same time, its distinctive specification, known history and 110th Anniversary status make it a fascinating addition to any collection.

A Morgan for the enthusiast who already knows great cars, but is still looking for a driving experience unlike anything else.
